Broders' Minneapolis Charitable Giving Policy

The purpose of our donation effort is to support our corporate objectives, impact/strengthen the well-being of our community and represent our corporate values publicly. We recognize the power of volunteerism, contributing financial resources, and collaborating with local businesses and non-profits to help make our communities better places to live and work.

Broders' Minneapolis supports many charitable and civic organizations. We frequently receive requests for gift certificates, which not-for-profit organizations then sell or auction to raise cash. We have also conducted fundraisers at our restaurants for such organizations as Slow Food MN, 2nd Harvest Heartland, The Aliveness Project, Fulton Farmers Market and others.

We are committed to building and maintaining ties with the community. However, we cannot honor every request for assistance which comes to us. If you are a philanthropic organization and desire a contribution from us, we ask that you first review the guidelines below.

Broders' Minneapolis will not contribute to:

- Individuals raising funds for personal activities
- Political organizations or candidates for public office
- Requests that are sensitive, controversial, or harmful or that pose a potential conflict of interest to Broders.
- Organizations that discriminate on the basis of religion, age, color, sex, disability, national origin, ancestry, marital status, sexual orientation, or veteran status
- Contributions for events/activities that have already occurred
- Activities that do not advance the public image or corporate purpose of Broders

SECULAR ORGANIZATIONS. Although we are mindful and appreciative of the charitable work done by religious organizations, it is our policy only to support secular organizations.

GEOGRAPHIC LIMITATIONS. Although we do not limit our giving to local organizations, we do give preference to organizations which support the local community in some fashion.

WE GIVE DIRECTLY TO CHARITIES. We are mindful of the good that is done by community foundations and organizations such as the United Way. But it is our policy to give directly to the organizations that perform these community services.

We support the following activities/goals (in no particular order):

- Protecting a healthy food supply.
- Alleviating hunger and food insecurity.
- Minneapolis public school meal/food programs.
- Aiding our urban disadvantaged people in education and job training to get them on a sustainable career path.
- Immigration programs supporting the pathway to citizenship.
- Preventing substance abuse, particularly in restaurant/food workers.
